ELEVATING EDUCATORS: A TEACHING TRAINING WORKSHOP

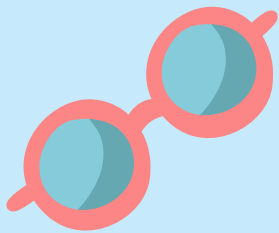
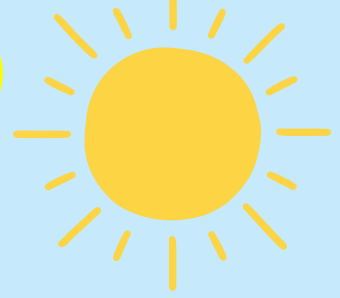

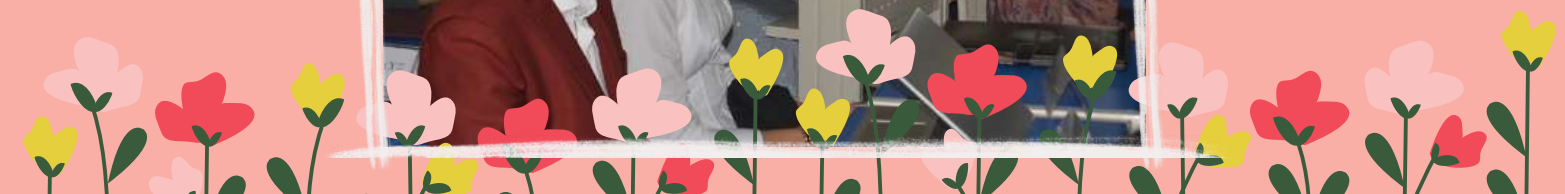
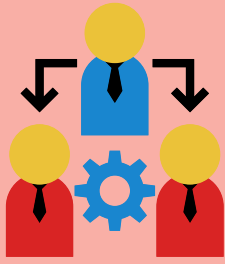
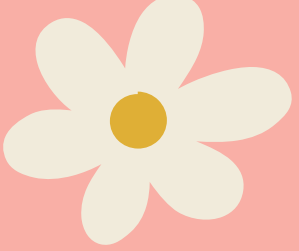
SAIMUN VI

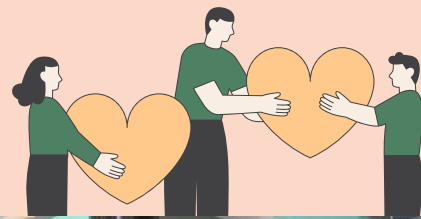


Thanks Giving Activity

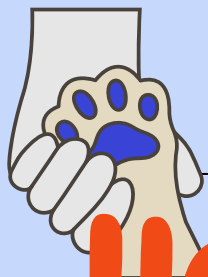




Joy of Giving

Your presence and appreciation will mean a lot to this budding actor and his family.

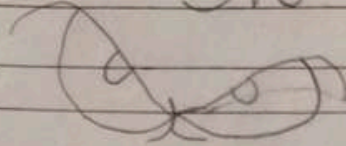

When I took birth everybody acted as if I was a stranger,

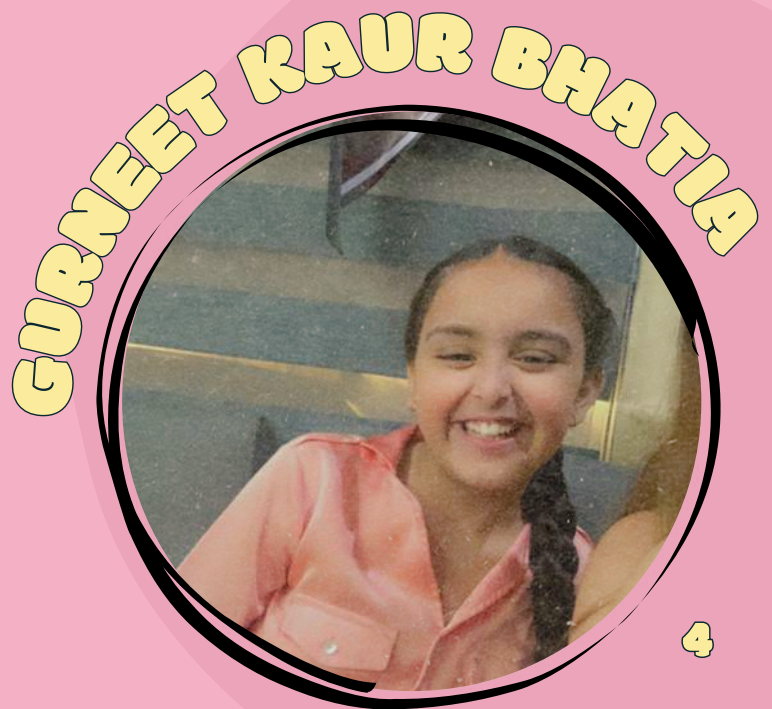
but my parents changed this mindlessness by becoming my life changer.

OPEN MINDS AND OPEN BOOKS

We are living in a time when the virus of rote learning, pathology of MCQ-centric tests, "success manuals" sold by coaching factories and psychology of fear associated with exams have polluted the culture of school education. In this context, open book examinations (OBEs) are a refreshing idea. We can orient young minds for OBEs only after succeeding in revolutionizing the ethos of the classroom. We need to take the spirit of critical pedagogy with absolute seriousness. This is possible only when children trust and realise their potential, and teachers, far from just completing "official syllabus", help students in seeing beyond bookish knowledge and overcoming dead weight of ready-made facts, definitions and theories. Second, OBEs should contain qualitatively unique questions and must not be just limited to "notes" and "guide book". Hence those who design papers should turn this task into a delicate art, which could be little challenging on their part but would be beneficial for their subjects. In fact, I love the idea of OBEs because throughout my school life I have celebrated my exams with the ecstasy of learning and unlearning, writing answers, I claim to be original and see a phenomenon in peculiar ways. Let examinations be a celebration of creative learning, not a toxic moment of doubt, cheating, fear and surveillance. Good luck to you CBSE!

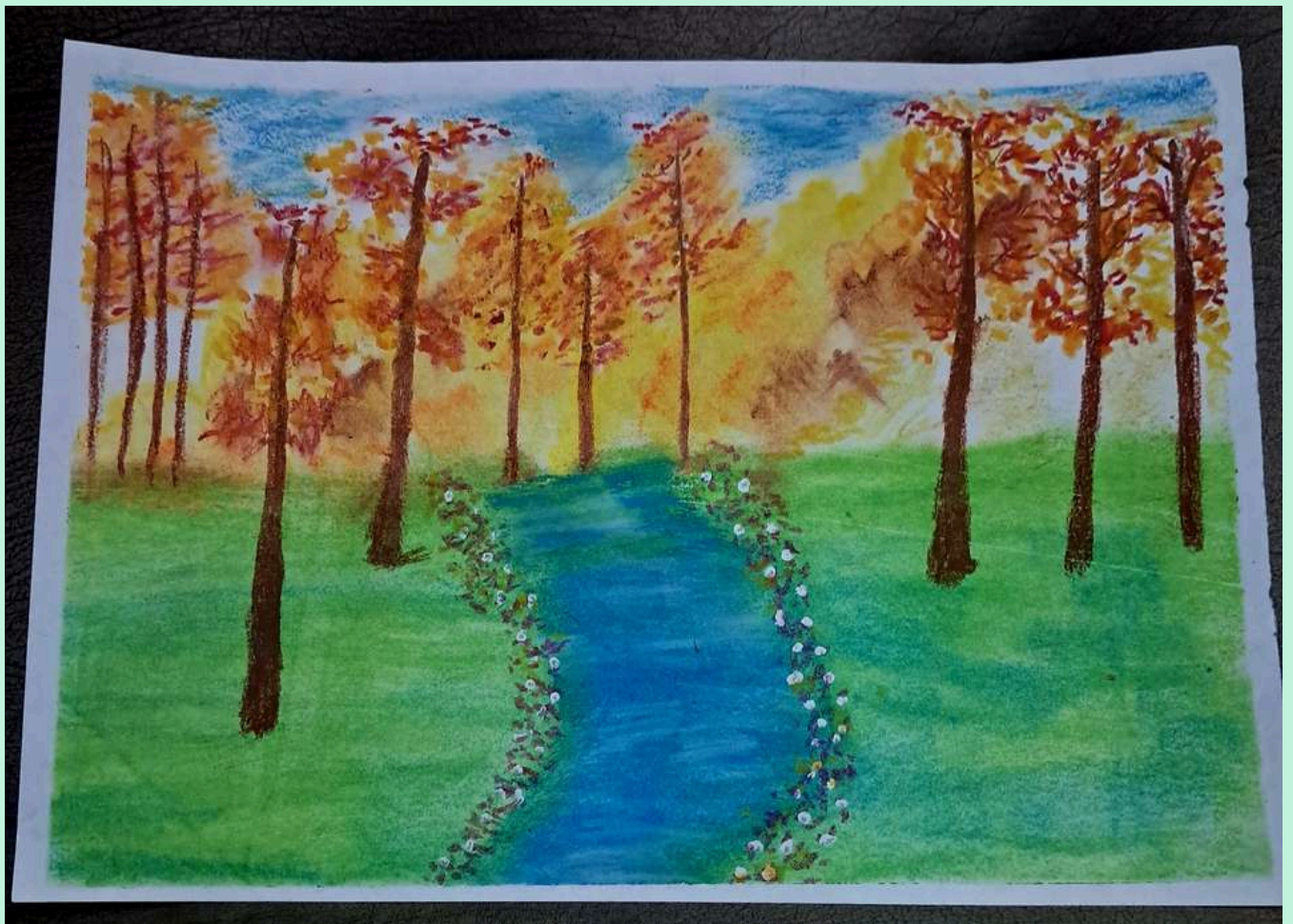

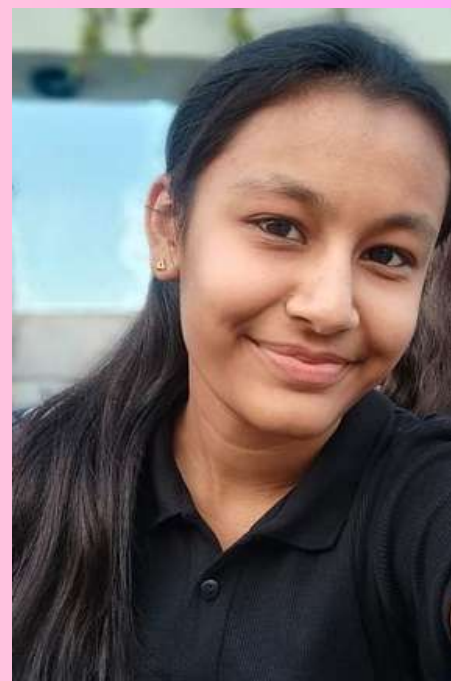
