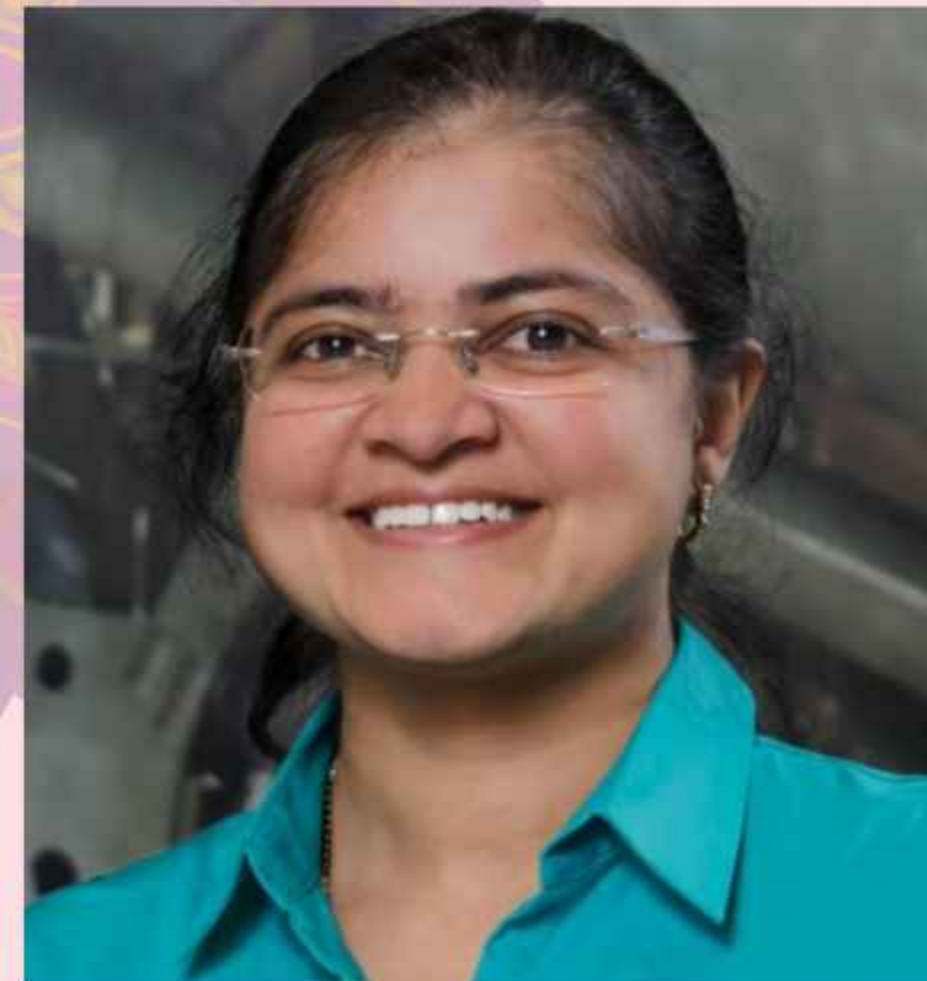
Alumnus **ACHIEVEMENT**



We are thrilled to highlight the extraordinary achievement of our alumna, **Professor Mansi Manoj Kasliwal**. She has been appointed as the new Palomar Observatory Director, making her the first woman to lead the historic facility. Ms. Mansi Kasliwal, a Professor of Astronomy at Caltech, is a globally acclaimed leader in time-domain and multi-messenger astrophysics. Her research centres around “cosmic fireworks” — spectacular stellar explosions and transients that reveal how stars are born, evolve, die, and generate the elements that shape our universe.

Her pioneering contributions to science have earned her many accolades, most notably the prestigious Breakthrough Prize in Physics (2022). With more than 440 refereed publications, an h-index of 100, and a leading role in gravitational-wave follow-up campaigns, she stands as a distinguished and influential figure in contemporary astrophysics.

Congratulations Mansi, for bringing great pride and glory not only to your alma mater but also to the country.





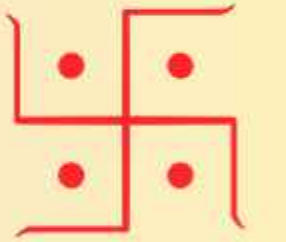
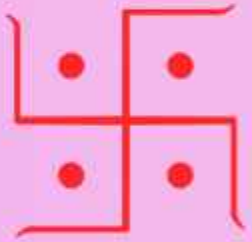
