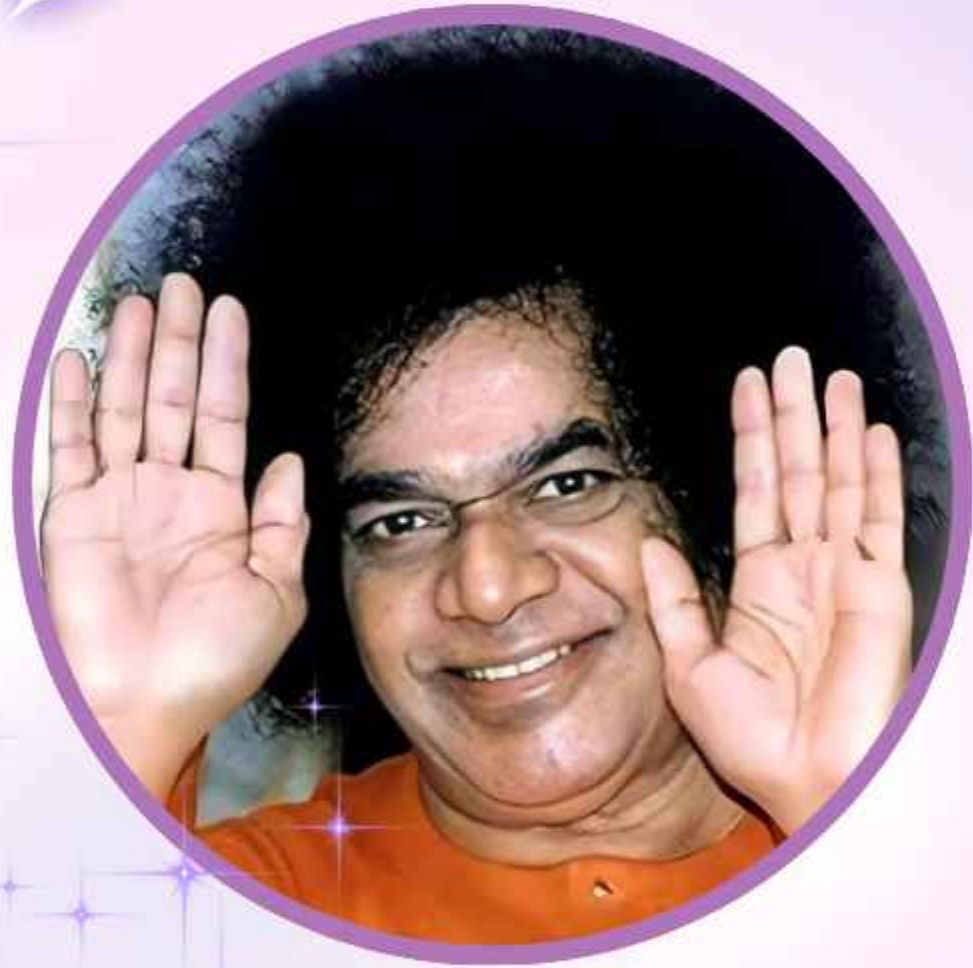

इंदौर के युवा उद्यमी करण राठी को राष्ट्रीय सम्मान, देश के टॉप 100 एमएसएमई में इंदौर शहर से एकमात्र चयन

गवर्नमेंट ऑफ इंडिया द्वारा देशभर से उन टॉप 100 एमएसएमई उद्यमों का चयन किया गया है, जो राष्ट्र निर्माण में सक्रिय भूमिका निभा रहे हैं और जिन्होंने जीएसटी 2.0 को अपने व्यवसाय में सफलतापूर्वक लागू किया है। इस प्रतिष्ठित सूची में इंदौर से एकमात्र चयन ग्लोबल पॉलीथेड्स के प्रॉपराइटर करण राठी का हुआ है, जो शहर और प्रदेश के लिए गौरव की बात है।

साथ डिनर कार्यक्रम में भी उनकी सहभागिता रहेगी। महज 30 वर्ष की उम्र में यह राष्ट्रीय सम्मान मिलना करण राठी के लिए एक बड़ी उपलब्धि है। यह सम्मान न केवल उनके व्यक्तिगत संघर्ष और सफलता को दर्शाता है, बल्कि इंदौर के उभरते एमएसएमई सेक्टर की क्षमता को भी राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर स्थापित करता है।
