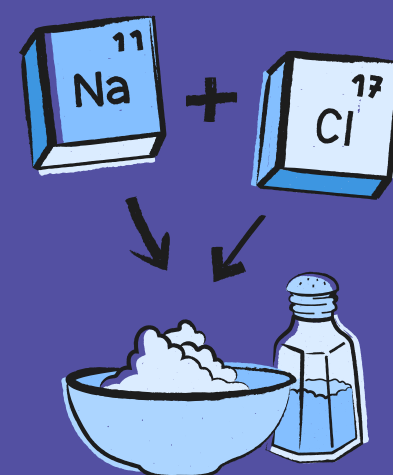
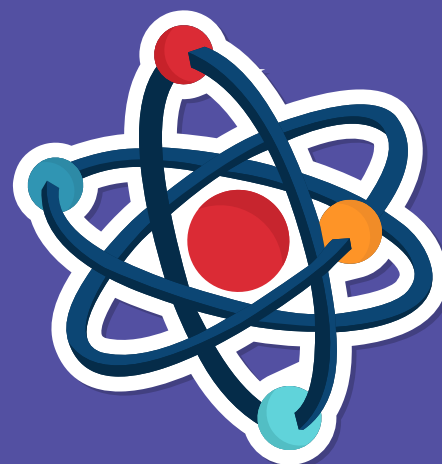


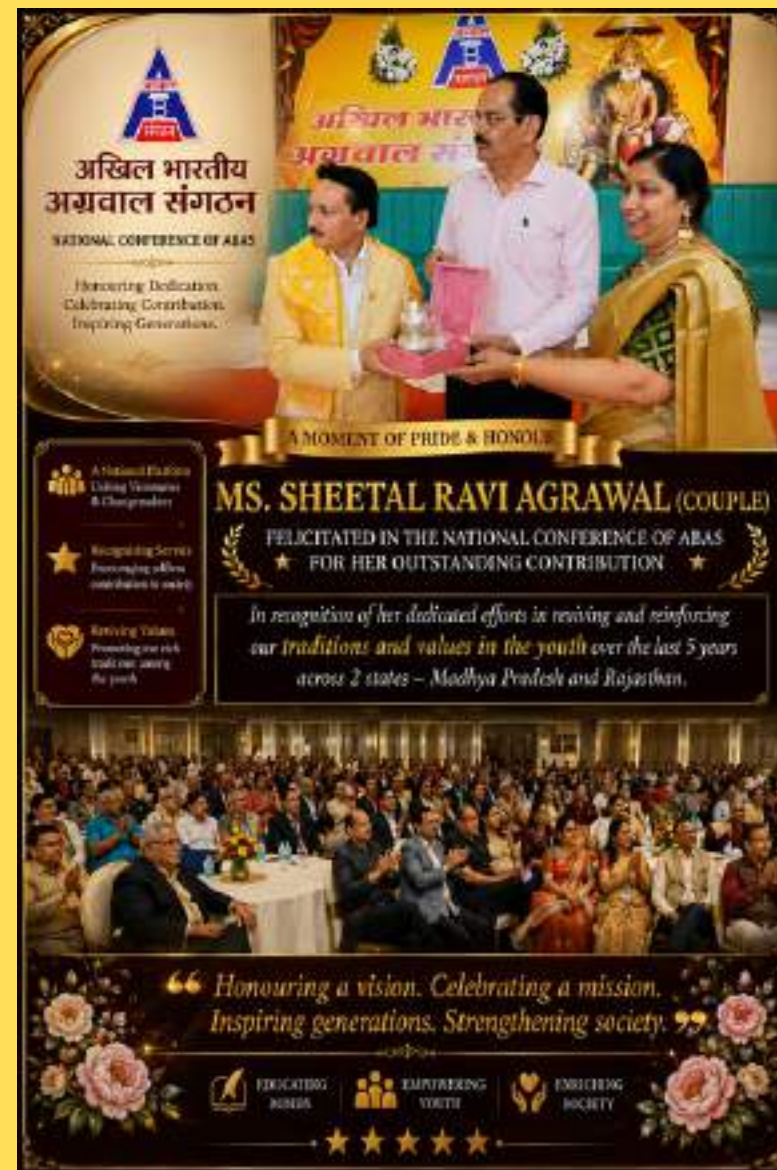
EDUCATORS' ACHIEVEMENTS

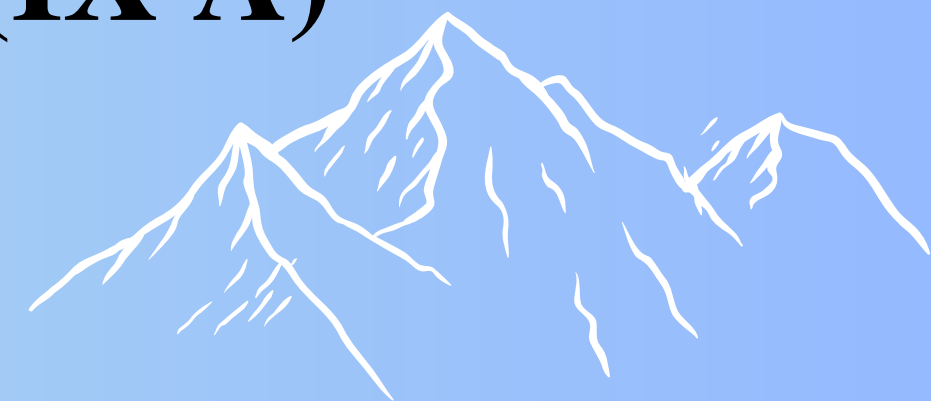


Enthusiastically battled snow blizzards, torrential rains, climbed over 19 Himalayan passes and successfully created a world record with her family to become member of “Largest convoy of single brand vehicles (Jimny, 32 cars) on the highest motorable road in the world – Umlingla – at 19024ft’.

She was the youngest in the family at 14 years age to beat high altitude sickness, spend over 60 minutes at the highest motorable point, play with snow, skid with black ice and negotiate worlds highest/longest hairpin bends in Gata Loops – and successfully return in the convoy after an adventure spanning 15 days, 19 passes, most adverse weather conditions one could fathom in the world and tell her story.

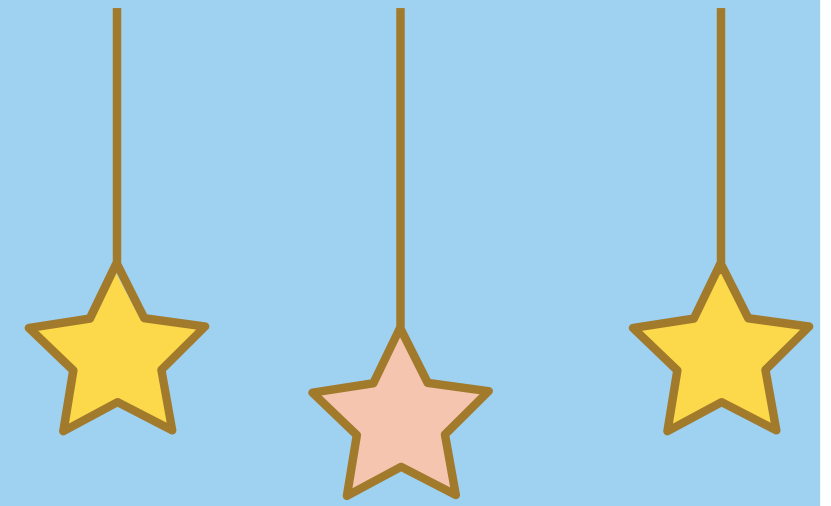
