Mr. Choudhary introduced the children to the fascinating world of Bonsai — the ancient Japanese art of growing and shaping trees in containers. The highlight of the workshop was a live demonstration on wiring and shaping, where the children witnessed how the form and aesthetics of a Bonsai are carefully crafted over time.

Mr. Veer Choudhary deftly demonstrated pruning and wiring a tree to turn it into a beautiful Bonsai. He magnanimously gifted the Bonsai tree created by him to Principal, Dr. Anju Chopra.

The session was highly interactive and engaging, with the children enthusiastically asking questions. Mr. Choudhary's passion and insights left the young learners deeply inspired, kindling in them a sense of creativity, environmental awareness and appreciation for nature's beauty. AI & INNOVATION SEMINAR

An insightful seminar on AI & Innovation was conducted by IMA bringing together distinguished speakers who shared their knowledge and experiences with the students.

The session was opened by CA Naveen Khandelwal, who introduced the concept of Artificial Intelligence and its promising future. He emphasized the growing importance of AI in shaping careers and industries, encouraging students to embrace this technological revolution.

The keynote address was delivered by Mr. Milind Raj, popularly known as “The Drone Man of India.” He shared his inspiring experiences with the Honourable Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam and stressed that the present is the best time for students to learn and apply Artificial Intelligence. He highlighted how small but focused efforts in the right direction can lead to life-changing outcomes. Advising students to set deadlines for even small tasks, he quoted one of Dr. Kalam’s valuable lessons: “Try to know something about everything, and everything about something.”

The seminar also featured Mr. Kumaar Bagrodia, widely recognized as India’s Brain Enhancer. He spoke about the conscious and subconscious mind, explaining how mindful living can transform one’s life. He informed the audience that although the human brain makes up only 2% of the body mass, it consumes nearly one-third of the body’s energy. With over a trillion neurons, he stressed the importance of developing and nurturing our mental potential.

The seminar left the students motivated and inspired, providing them with valuable insights into Artificial Intelligence, innovation and the limitless power of the human mind.

A segment on Sathya Sai Baba, who was portrayed as a true embodiment of Ram-like virtues—spreading love, peace, and selfless service to humanity.



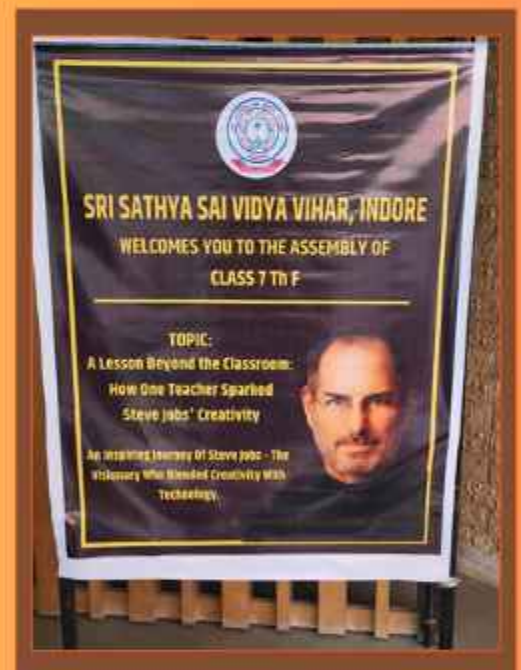

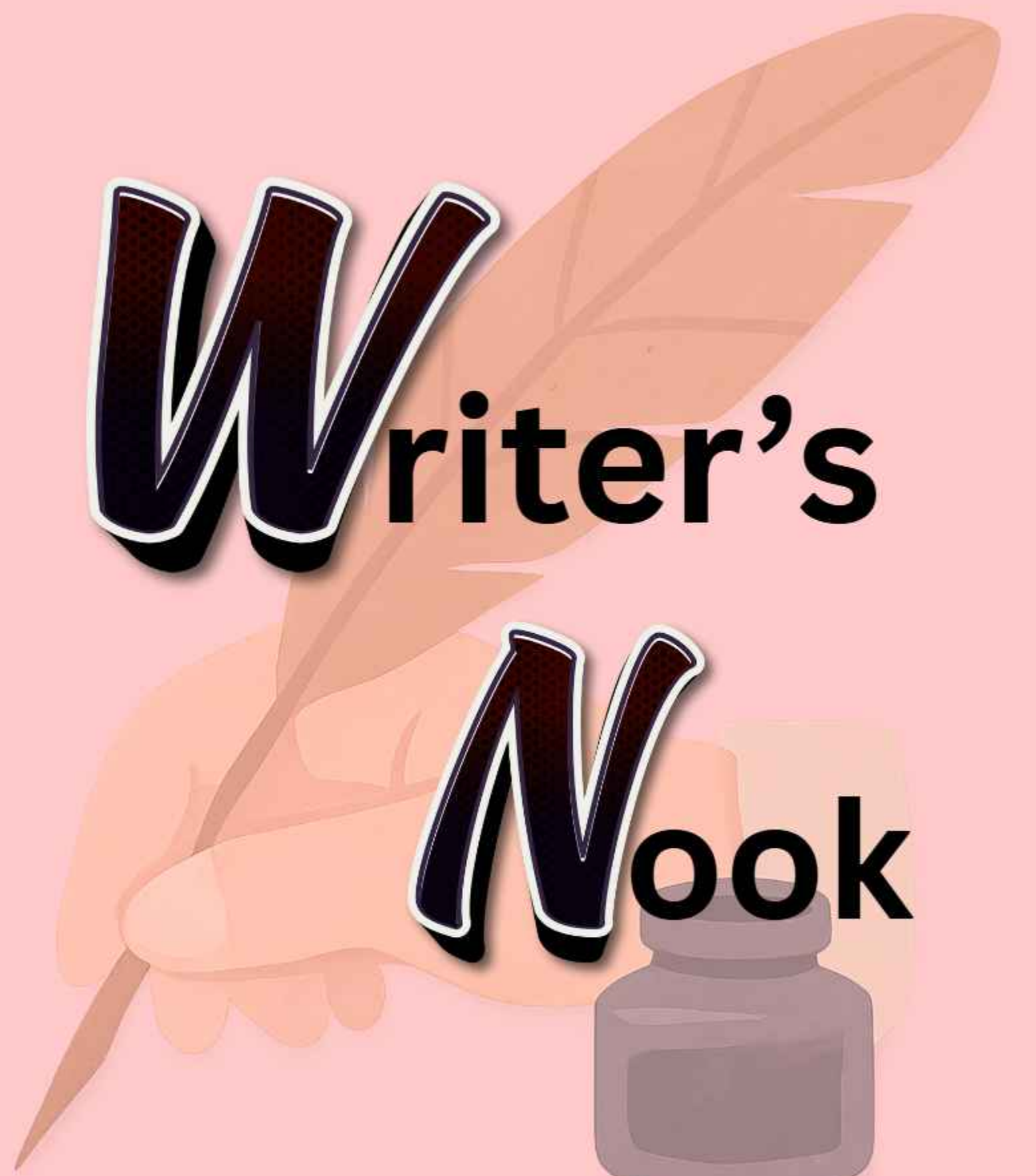

Suicides of Farmers: Is It Normal?

In 2022, a total of 11, 290 individuals in the farming sector, including 5,207 farmers and 6,083 agricultural labourers, committed suicide in India. This number accounted for 6.6% of all suicide victims in the country. These numbers are not merely some random figures; they have been cited in research papers.

It's hard to believe, but every hour in our country, a farmer or farm labourer loses their life. This dark reality is a reminder of the challenges they face daily, often going unnoticed by many of us.

What are the reasons?

Several farmers face financial crises, extreme poverty, debts, corruption in subsidies, threats and most of all, they find farming expensive, meticulous and requiring huge amounts of investments. Imagine farming being costly, even though we buy its fruits at unreasonably low prices!

The Government, though, has made schemes and policies and even introduced insurance for their sake, but it would be foolish of us to even hope that they would get even 1/10 of their share. This is called "The change corruption has brought in".

Beyond cultural pressures and mental health stigma, rural living poses significant challenges for farmers. Many reside far from mental healthcare resources, making it difficult to seek help.

Various reports suggest that a significant percentage of Indian farmers, potentially over 20%, live below the poverty line. And after all these burdens on them, they almost gain the right to end their lives! Though they aren't in prisons, the social norms and the 'system' are no less than guns on one's forehead.



Now, let's ask ourselves a question: "Do we expect change here?"

"Yes, we do."

National Suicide Prevention Strategy (NSPS): India launched its National Suicide Prevention Strategy (NSPS) on November 21, 2022, marking the first public health policy focused on suicide prevention. The strategy aims to reduce suicide mortality by 10% by 2030, compared to 2020 levels.

Enhancing Financial Security and Risk Mitigation: Improve access to affordable credit, implement effective debt relief and crop insurance, promote income diversification, and invest in irrigation and agricultural research to increase productivity and reduce reliance on rain-fed agriculture.

Strengthening Mental Health Support and Policy: Establish accessible mental health services in rural areas, reduce stigma, educate farmers about financial and mental well-being, and implement government policies that focus on income stability, risk reduction, and social welfare for farmers.

Implementing these kinds of strategies is not just important; it is vital for achieving success and driving meaningful progress.

It is rightly said, "When tillage begins, other arts follow. The farmers, therefore, are the founders of human civilisation."

HOW BIG AND BEAUTIFUL.....

"Do it proportionately" warns Federal Reserve Chair Jeremy Powell, once an obscure figure and now a worldwide talking point, following the narrow clearance of Trump's Federal Reserve bill, which has been received in the House of Representatives - there's much brouhaha on whether Senate gives it a green flag; there remains general indifference towards it due to months of asinine simplification of a well-meaning law with noble intentions as that of an accountable public office-bearer willfully delivering what he promised and made the core base of his second term campaigning- tax cuts for Americans. While all is not beautiful about Trump's bill, lowering taxes is an idea too romantic to resist.

Persisting apprehensions arise due to a clause in the controversy mired bill, increasing the debt ceiling of federal borrowing. 25% of national income of the USA currently goes into paying interest, and Elon Musk, who has gone a way too far in criticising the bill is primarily worried about generations of homegrown businesses and American money possibly paying much larger interest rates, given the bill gets cleared. However, the solution to this not-so-peculiar situation may lie with Powell himself, Trump has called him out for not lowering interest rates, citing the fact that European counterparts have done so up to as high as nine times. Apart from these propositions, the bill includes more stringent regulations for availing social security, gives the federal government exclusive rights to administer AI-related regulations for up to 10 years, exempts taxes on tips and overtime, reverses green taxes, among other ones. These changes are, if not welcome, then surely acceptable.



As for the numbers, the bill's tax provisions alone would reduce federal tax revenue by \$4.0 trillion from 2025 to 2034 on a conventional basis before added interest costs. On a dynamic basis, accounting for economic growth, the revenue reduction would fall by about 22 percent to \$3.1 trillion over 10 years. However, by introducing narrowly targeted new provisions and sunseting several pro-growth provisions, it complicates the structure of the tax code, according to estimates by researchers at Tax Department Organisation.

The US is not any country. If the US were a small country, then we could sideline the effect of its domestic rubric on our collective trajectory, but the US is the largest economy in the world and the largest importer as well; therefore, in principle, the largest market.

Although some positions of this bill might be theoretically indefensible, they become spectacular and pressing for the market at large.

Some may find Trump's new bill rather ugly, but beauty still lies in the eyes of the beholder.

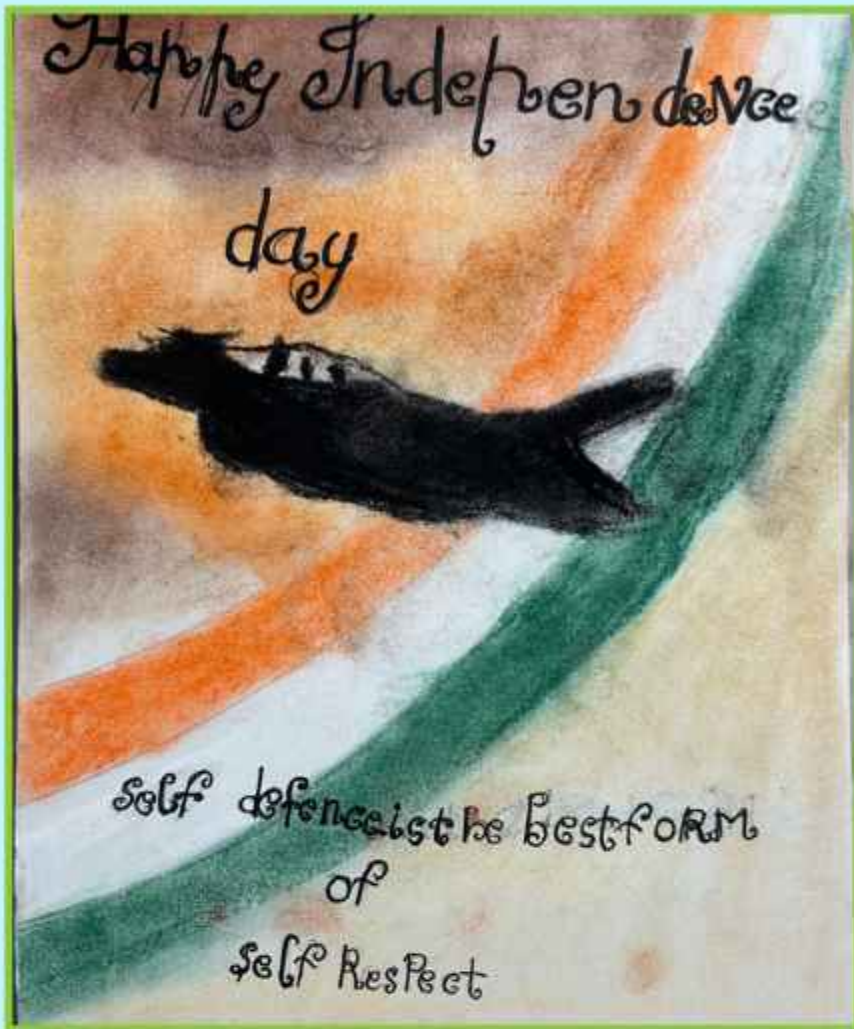

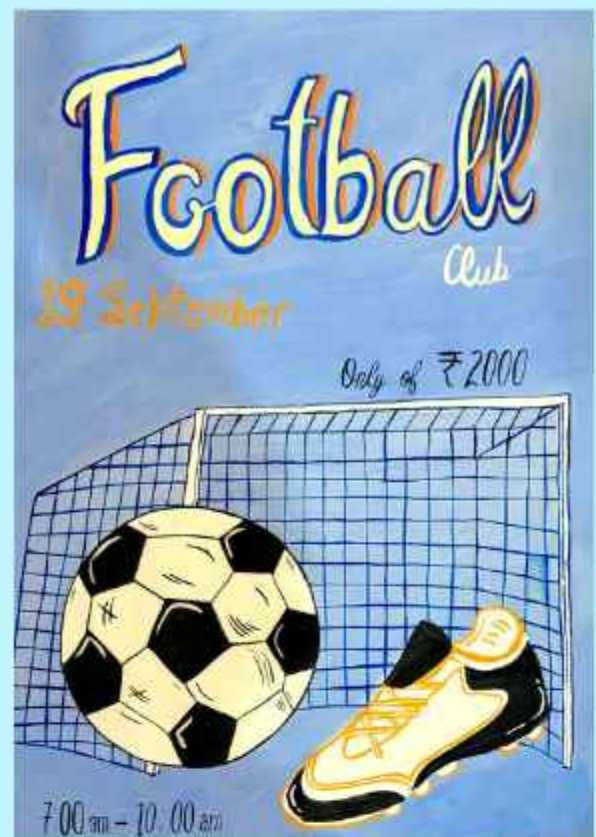
